Slug or round ball from bench rest

50-yard and 25-yard will be off-hand - Open sights only (shaders allowed)

Paper Targets - May have some novelty targets at the 25-yard line

Black powder or black powder substitute only - no smokeless powder

Food will be available (hamburgers, hot dogs, and cold drinks)

This will be our first muzzleloading rifle match. With enough support it could become a regular event. This is a premier facility. Come out and enjoy the day with us.
